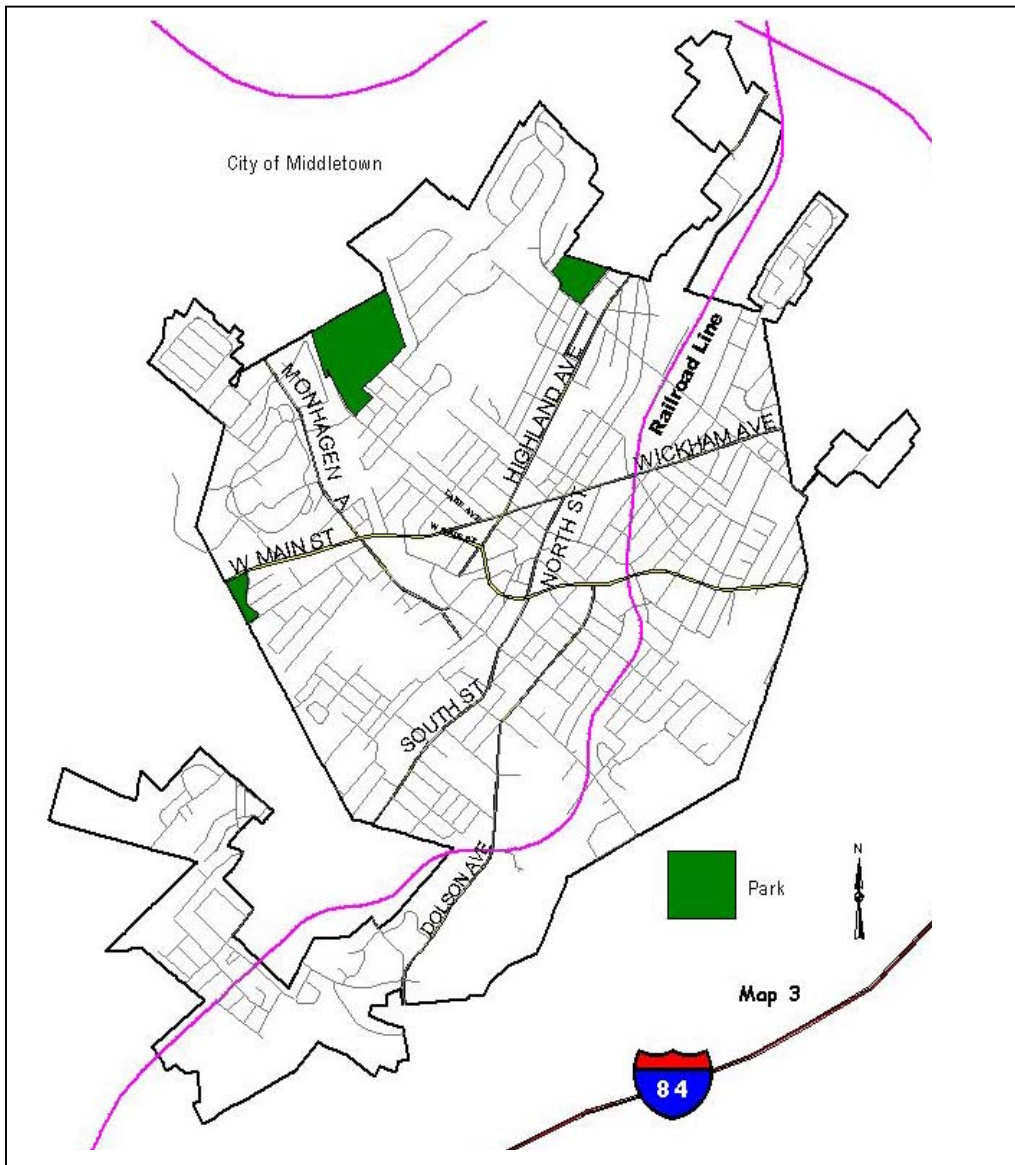


Community Profile: Middletown City



- Chartered in 1888; ~5 square miles in area
- No natural features aided its development. Terminus for Erie Railroad helped to create it.
- During 1900's was a manufacturing center; Today its leading industrial category is services (education, health, social)
- Elevations range between 500-600 feet above sea level; sections of relatively flat topography with areas of steep slope
- Monhagen Brook major water feature
- Complex road network.

Portions of 2 State Roads Route 211 (Wickham Ave) and 17M (Monhagen Ave) serve as major Corridors to shopping and commercial areas.

- Census 2000 had a population of 25,388; 5% increase since 1990. 69% single race white, 15% black, 2% Asian; 25 % Hispanic; Median age ~ 33; Median HH income \$39,570.
- 18% individuals below poverty; 29% have a high school diploma
- 10,124 total Housing Units:42% built prior to 1939; 54% are renter occupied; 52% are multi family
