# On-line Training available May 1, 2011!

As discussed at training sessions, we have invested a good portion of our Help America Vote Act Grant into an Election Inspector On-Line Training Program. We are pleased to announce our on-line training program will be up and running on **May 1, 2011!** This program allows Election Inspectors to complete their Mandatory Procedural Training Session online including the Certification Test from the convenience of home! Once inspectors complete their training and testing online, they will be certified for Procedural Training. The system will enable inspectors to review ALL parts of training over and over again; from Election Day Procedures to Machine Operations. Inspectors will be compensated \$25.00, one time once session is completed.

**Don't panic!!** Inspectors will also be provided the option of attending Procedural classes throughout the County for anyone who does not have access to a computer or if you just like the classroom setting! Schedules for classes are being scheduled for the month of June.

Inspectors will be required to attend Machine Operator Training Sessions offered by the BOE in August and October. Notices for that training will be sent out in the summer. **Inspectors who do not have internet access are asked to contact the Coordinators as soon as possible so we may figure out our training schedule needs for 2011.**
