**Disaster Debris Management Policy**

Orange County Deputy County Executive James D. O'Donnell has instructed the Orange County Department of Public Works Division of Environmental Facilities and Services to implement the following procedures regarding Disaster Debris Management to provide relief to Orange County Municipalities. Orange County tipping fees at the three Orange County Solid Waste Transfer Stations in New Hampton, Newburgh and Port Jervis will be waived on Thursday, September 1, Friday, September 2, and Saturday, September 3, for all disaster debris received by the transfer stations. The disaster debris may be brought to the transfer stations by municipal vehicles, contracted vendors of municipalities and private vehicles.

Orange County Division of Environmental Facilities & Services is requiring that all Disaster Debris must be delivered to the Transfer Stations separated into various types of waste:

**Metals and appliances** such as water heaters, furnaces, refrigerators, washing machines, dryers, dish washers and like items

**Mixed Debris** such as carpets, rugs, bedding, decorations, clothing, and wood furniture

**The tipping fees for regular household garbage are not waived by Orange County.**

Wood products including trees, branches, stumps, pallets and unadulterated lumber can be brought to Wessels' Farms, 94 Bull Road, Otisville, NY 10963 for no charge. Contact Mike Wessels at (845)386-5681.

Household Hazardous Waste will be collected by the Orange County Division of Environmental Facilities & Services on Friday, September 16, for businesses, government agencies, schools and farms, registration required (no charge for municipalities and schools for this event) and Saturday September 17, for Orange County residents at a location to be announced. All residents are requested to retain their Household Hazardous Waste in a safe and secure container until the disposal date listed above.
