District Attorney David Hoover, Sheriff Carl DuBois and Acting-Chief / Lt. Joseph Cortez, Announce the Arrest of Twelve (12) Subjects for Prostitution and Patronizing a Prostitute in the City of Newburgh, N.Y.

The Orange County Drug Task Force and City of Newburgh Police Department Charges five (5) Defendants With Prostitution And seven (7) Defendants with Patronizing a Prostitute.

City of Newburgh, NY - On May 11, 2017, the Orange County Drug Task Force and the City of Newburgh Police Department conducted a joint “Prostitution sting”, in the City of Newburgh, N.Y. Five (5) women were arrested and charged with Prostitution, a Class “B” misdemeanor. Seven (7) men were arrested and charged with Patronizing a Prostitute in the Third Degree, a Class “A” misdemeanor.

Sheriff Carl E. DuBois stated that, “My office is committed to fight the scourge of quality of life crimes, illicit drug use and abuse that plague our communities.”

“This operation was in response to community complaints,” said District Attorney David M. Hoover. “As my office responds to these quality of life crimes, we are also investigating whether there is a human tracking component to these crimes.”

A criminal charge is merely an allegation by the police that a defendant has committed a violation of the criminal law, and it is not evidence of guilt. All defendants are presumed innocent and entitled to a fair trial, during which it will be the State of New York’s burden to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
