**Commissioners Report – Lacey Trimble, Deputy Commissioner**

- Tenise noted private pay for medication suboxone is not consistent, one week \$300 for a two week script, the next week as high as 400. Cost to people in need without coverage is a barrier.
- Pat noted a client, recently out of a half-way house, trying to connect with Catholic Charities for continued outpatient treatment, has been unable to get a response, Pat herself called and left a message, it's been two weeks and still no response from Catholic Charities.

Lacey recommended the new Access Urgent Care and the Crisis Call Center for possible ways to connect/address both issues noted above.
