- Introduction of Lacey Trimble, Deputy Commissioner.
- Changing the Orange County Addiction Treatment Ecosystem workgroup will produce “products” in December 2018. There are currently five sub-workgroups: Prevention; Consent/Releases; Medication Assisted Treatment Expansion; Assessment Tools; and First Responders.
- New Legislative Opiate Epidemic Committee has been formed, September 20th they will hold their first meeting, this committee consists of four Legislators and Darcie, they have budgeted \$10,000 for marketing regarding the opioid epidemic.
- An anonymous donor donated “yard signs” that promote the Help line number for those impacted by addiction to be distributed and posted throughout Orange County.
- Crisis Services continuum flow chart was distributed to board members for their review. We will be creating a single point of access & help line. This is a collaboration with ACCESS Support for Living, Inc. Mental Health Association in Orange County, and Independent Living, Inc.
 - No funding yet, but we will have it by January 1, 2019
 - Co-located at the Emergency Services 911 Center.
 - Matches w/Corey Waller report and has the potential to fill a tremendous gap in services.
- Jeanne Jonas Profession Development and Frank Masterson’s Banquet will be held on November 14, at the Villa Venezia in Middletown.

- Budget – expectation was to come in “flat” we came in over, and our budget has been accepted as submitted.
- Orange County has a new Health Commissioner, Dr. Irina Gelman. Darcie has met with her on a couple of occasions and looks forward to collaborating with the Health Dept. in the future.
