

**Resolution 2019-05**

**Self-Certification of 2020-2024 OCTC Planning Process**

**WHEREAS**, the Orange County Transportation Council has been designated by the Governor of the State of New York as the Metropolitan Planning Organization responsible, together with the State, for the comprehensive, continuing, and cooperative transportation planning process for Orange County; and,

**WHEREAS**, Title 23 CFR Part 450 and Title 49 CFR Part 613 require that a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) be developed and adopted by the Metropolitan Planning Organization; and,

**WHEREAS**, it is the responsibility of the OCTC to ensure that said policy, planning, and programming process is consistent with applicable Federal and State law, and is also consistent with local area objectives; and

**WHEREAS**, the State and the MPO must certify annually that the MPO planning process is being carried out in conformance with all applicable requirements of specific Federal Acts and regulations;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Orange County Transportation Council hereby approves the 2019 OCTC Self-Certification (as shown in Attachment 1); and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the OCTC Secretary shall transmit this Resolution and Attachment 1 to the New York State Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration, and Federal Transit Administration.
