**Revision to the Orange County Transportation Committee (OCTC) FFY 2020-2024
Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Narrative**

WHEREAS, the Orange County Transportation Council (OCTC) has been designated by the Governor of the State of New York as the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) responsible, together with the State, for the comprehensive, continuing, and cooperative transportation planning process for Orange County; and,

WHEREAS, the federal surface transportation programs that are the responsibility of the Orange County Transportation Council are authorized by the Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act; and

WHEREAS, Title 23 U.S.C. Section 134 requires that a Metropolitan Planning Organization, in cooperation with the state, develop a TIP for the Metropolitan Planning Area; and

WHEREAS, the TIP narrative portion of the OCTC FFY 2020-2024 TIP was previously adopted on September 26, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the TIP narrative is an accompanying document which details and explains the TIP and TIP processes; and


WHEREAS, the TIP anticipated effects portion of the TIP narrative, shown in Attachment 1, has been revised to include specific language stating the OCTC supports the New York State Department of Transportation's (NYSDOT) four-year statewide emissions reduction target for Particulate Matter 2.5, through the use of Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement program funds, and has been doing so since the target was set; and

WHEREAS, a 14-day public comment period on the revision to the OCTC FFY 2020-2024 TIP Narrative was held beginning November 12, 2019 and ending November 25, 2019 resulted in no comments; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Orange County Transportation Council hereby revises the 2020-2024 TIP as shown in Attachment 1.
