

**Resolution 2019-14**

**Adopt the Orange County Transportation Committee (OCTC) FFY 2020-2024  
Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Narrative**

**WHEREAS**, the Orange County Transportation Council (OCTC) has been designated by the Governor of the State of New York as the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) responsible, together with the State, for the comprehensive, continuing, and cooperative transportation planning process for Orange County; and,

**WHEREAS**, the federal surface transportation programs that are the responsibility of the Orange County Transportation Council are authorized by the Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act; and

**WHEREAS**, Title 23 U.S.C. Section 134 requires that a Metropolitan Planning Organization, in cooperation with the state, develop a TIP for the Metropolitan Planning Area; and

**WHEREAS**, the five-year capital program portion of the OCTC FFY 2020-2024 TIP was previously adopted on August 20, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the TIP narrative, shown in Attachment 1, is an accompanying document which details and explains the TIP and TIP processes; and

**WHEREAS**, a 14-day public comment period on the OCTC FFY 2020-2024 TIP Narrative was held beginning September 12, 2019 and ending September 25, 2019 resulted in no comments; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the OCTC FFY 2020-2024 Transportation Improvement Program Narrative is hereby approved.
