Adoption of Revised Orange County Transportation Council Operating Procedures

WHEREAS, the Orange County Transportation Council (OCTC) has been designated by the Governor of the State of New York as the Metropolitan Planning Organization responsible, together with the State, for the comprehensive, continuing, and cooperative transportation planning process for the Orange County area of the Poughkeepsie-Newburgh NY-NJ Urbanized Area; and

WHEREAS, in view of its transportation planning responsibilities the Orange County Transportation Council has prepared an update to its Operating Procedures to demonstrate compliance with the various Federal requirements as well as to generally update the procedures through which the Orange County Transportation Council carries out its activities; and,

WHEREAS, the draft Operating Procedures document was available throughout the drafting process on the Orange County Transportation Council website and the final draft document was made available for the required forty-five-day public comment period, during which one technical correction comment was received and the appropriate updates made; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Orange County Transportation Council hereby adopts the revised Operating Procedures.
