

**Resolution 2021-11**

**Adoption of the Title VI/Non-discrimination Plan for the  
Orange County Transportation Council**

**WHEREAS**, the Orange County Transportation Council (OCTC) has been designated by the Governor of the State of New York as the Metropolitan Planning Organization responsible, together with the State, for the comprehensive, continuing, and cooperative transportation planning process for the Orange County area of the Poughkeepsie-Newburgh NY-NJ Urbanized Area; and

**WHEREAS**, the Orange County Transportation Council is a recipient of federal funding and is required to develop a Title VI program in accordance with the Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987; and

**WHEREAS**, the goal of Title VI/Nondiscrimination Plan is to ensure that people are not adversely impacted by programs or activities the Orange County Transportation Council undertakes, regardless of race, color, sex, age, disability or national origin; and

**WHEREAS**, the Title VI/Nondiscrimination Plan fulfills the necessary requirements for the Orange County Transportation Council to address the requirements for a Metropolitan Planning Organization; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Orange County Transportation Council hereby adopts the Title VI/Nondiscrimination Plan.
