What Is Substance Abuse Disorder?

Substance Abuse Disorder is a term used to refer to the broad range of problems associated with Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse. This may include various forms of dependency including Alcoholism and other Addiction problems as well as less clearly defined abuses of various substances both legal and illegal.

What services are available?

Types of Treatment and Prevention Services:

There are various types of services that may have a positive effect on people in regard to their use or potential use and/or abuse of alcohol and other drugs. They may include **"Prevention"** services, which are designed to prevent the use or abuse of substances. **"Intervention"** services, which are ways of identifying persons with problems or potential alcohol and substance abuse problems then linking to treatment. **"Treatment"** services, which help people to stop using and abusing substances and recover from the effects of use and abuse. **"Recovery"** and other supports which are formal and informal services available for continuing and maintaining a recovery oriented life.
