

Early Notice and Public Review of Proposed  
Activities in a 100-Year Floodplain  
County of Orange

To: All interested Agencies, Groups and Individuals

This is to give notice that Orange County has conducted an evaluation as required by Executive Orders 11988 and 11990, in accordance with HUD regulations at 24 CFR 55.20 Subpart C Procedures for Making Determinations on Floodplain Management, to determine the potential effect that its activities in the floodplain and wetlands will have on the human environment for the county's 2019 Community Development Block Grant Program and Home Investment Partnerships Program that are funded through grants from HUD. The proposed activities are:

There are three primary purposes for this notice. First, people who may be affected by activities in floodplains and those who have an interest in the protection of the natural environment should be given an opportunity to express their concerns and provide information about these areas. Second, an adequate public notice program can be an important public educational tool. The dissemination of information about floodplains can facilitate and enhance federal efforts to reduce the risks associated with the occupancy and modification of these special areas. Third, as a matter of fairness, when the federal government determines it will participate in actions taking place in floodplains, it must inform those who may be put at greater or continued risk.
