Deputies and Troopers Save a Life

Village of Unionville, NY— On October 8th, 2019, Sheriff's Deputies and New York State Troopers responded to an Emergency 911 call in the Village of Unionville, Orange County, for a report of a 27-year-old woman who was not breathing and unresponsive. While en route to the location, Orange 911 advised they were giving CPR instructions to the caller and CPR had been started. Upon arrival on scene, the woman was still not breathing and showing signs of opioid overdose. Two doses of Narcan, a temporary Opioid blocker, were administered to the woman and then CPR was started again. The woman began breathing again but was still unconscious. An additional dose of Narcan was administered and the woman regained consciousness. She was transported to the hospital by Greenville ambulance for observation. Sheriff Carl DuBois stated, "Thanks to the quick thinking of deputies and troopers, a life has been saved and provided a second chance and an opportunity to seek substance abuse help."
