1. Lake District elections are held each year on the second Tuesday of December.
2. Board members are elected by the Resident Electors of the Lake District and are elected to represent the entire District.
3. The Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Secretary are elected for one year by the Board at the annual re-organization meeting usually held in January.
4. No nominating petitions were filed to fill this office by election during the 12/11/2018 election cycle. Current office holder was appointed on 1/9/2019 by the District Board to fill vacancy until 12/31/2019. This office is available to be filled for the 2 year unexpired balance of term during the 12/10/2019 election cycle.
5. Term is out of original 3 year sequence due to special election and change in original term made by resolution of County Legislature in 2018. The next Term Start Date will be 1/1/2021 and the term will run for 3 years unless restored to original term sequence by County Legislature.
6. No nominating petitions were filed to fill this office by election during the 12/11/2018 election cycle. Position has been vacant since 1/1/2019. Term was out of original sequence due to error made in district election of December 2009 where election was held for 3 year term instead of the 2 year unexpired balance of vacated office. The end date of the term sequence was corrected to restore the original 3 year sequence by District Board action dated October 9, 2019. This office is available to be filled for the 1 year unexpired balance of the term during the 12/10/2019 election cycle.
