

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE:

Due to the overwhelming response to the Greenlight Law, County Clerk Annie Rabbitt is modifying the processing hours at the Goshen DMV from 9am-12pm. These hours are subject to change. There will be no Learner's Permits processed on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve. Currently the only Orange County location equipped to handle the increased volume is the Goshen DMV at 255 Main Street.

County Clerk Rabbitt cautions some of the wait time may include a line that forms outside the building so please be prepared.

This law directs NYS DMV's to issue drivers licenses to undocumented residents. As County Clerk Rabbitt previously stated she will comply with the Greenlight Law, however, undocumented residents must meet all the requirements. County Clerk Rabbitt anticipates long delays due to the volume of applicants and the lack of resources provided by NYS to implement this Greenlight Law.

The long wait you may experience is a NYS issue and not an Orange County issue. County Clerk Rabbitt and her staff at the Goshen DMV are committed to providing quality service.
