

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON LOCAL LAW

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that there has been presented to the County Executive of the County of Orange on February 10th, 2020, Local Laws, a summary of which reads as follows:

Local Law Introductory No. 1 of 2020 is a local law fixing compensation for the Legislators of the Orange County Legislature for the term commencing January 1, 2022 pursuant to the Orange County Charter Section 2.02(s).

This local law fixes the compensation for the Legislators for the period of January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2025 as follows: January 1, 2022 - \$32,196; January 1, 2023 - \$33,242; January 1, 2024 - \$33,907 and January 1, 2025 - \$34,585.

Local Law Introductory No. 2 of 2020 is a local law fixing compensation for the Chairpersons of the Statutory Committees of the Orange County Legislature for the term commencing January 1, 2022 pursuant to the Orange County Charter Section 2.02(s).

This local law fixes the compensation for the Chairpersons of the Statutory Committees for the period of January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2025 as follows: January 1, 2022 - \$35,774; January 1, 2023 - \$36,937; January 1, 2024 - \$37,675 and January 1, 2025 - \$38,429.

Local Law Introductory No. 3 of 2020 is a local law which establishes the annual stipend for the Chair of the Green Committee, a Special Committee of the Orange County Legislature. The Chair of the Green Committee shall receive \$1,000, in addition to the annual salary received as a member of the Legislature, for the years 2022, 2023, 2024 and 2025. The compensation shall commence on January 1, of each year.

Local Law Introductory No. 4 of 2020 is a local law fixing compensation for the Majority and Minority Leaders of the Orange County Legislature for the term commencing January 1, 2022 pursuant to the Orange County Charter Section 2.02(s).

This local law fixes the compensation for the Majority and Minority Leaders for the period of January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2025 as follows: January 1, 2022 - \$39,351; January 1, 2023 - \$40,630; January 1, 2024 - \$41,442 and January 1, 2025 - \$42,271.

Local Law Introductory No. 5 of 2020 is a local law fixing compensation for the Party Leader, other than the Majority or Minority Leader, of the Orange County Legislature for the term commencing January 1, 2022 pursuant to the Orange County Charter Section 2.02(s).

This local law fixes the compensation for the Party Leader for the period of January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2025 as follows: January 1, 2022 - \$39,351; January 1, 2023 - \$40,630; January 1, 2024 - \$41,442 and January 1, 2025 - \$42,271.

Local Law Introductory No. 6 of 2020 is a local law fixing compensation for the Chairman of the Orange County Legislature for the term commencing January 1, 2022 pursuant to the Orange County Charter Section 2.02(s).

This local law fixes the compensation for the Chairman for the period of January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2025 as follows: January 1, 2022 - \$53,659; January 1, 2023 - \$55,403; January 1, 2024 - \$56,511 and January 1, 2025 - \$57,641.

Local Law Introductory No. 7 of 2020 is a local law fixing compensation for the County Clerk of Orange County for the term commencing January 1, 2022 pursuant to the Orange County Charter Section 2.02(g).

This local law fixes the compensation for the County Clerk for the period of January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2025 as follows: January 1, 2022 - \$116,262; January 1, 2023- \$120,041; January 1, 2024 - \$122,441 and January 1, 2025 - \$124,890.

Local Law Introductory No. 8 of 2020 is a local law fixing compensation for the County Executive of Orange County for the term commencing January 1, 2022 pursuant to the Orange County Charter Section 2.02(g).

This local law fixes the compensation for the County Executive for the period of January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2025 as follows: January 1, 2022 - \$186,276; January 1, 2023- \$190,002; January 1, 2024 - \$193,802 and January 1, 2025 - \$197,678.

These local laws shall take effect as provided in Section 24 of the New York State Municipal Home Rule Law and upon completion of the requisite filings and procedures.

Therefore, pursuant to Section 20 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, the County Executive of the County of Orange will hold a public hearing on the aforesaid Local Law at 255 Main Street, Goshen, New York, on the 2nd day of March 2020, at 11 o'clock in the morning of that day, at which time all persons interested therein will be heard.
