

What's in store for this summer?

The first priority for all Youth Bureau funded programs is the health and safety of the youth they serve. Most year-round/school-year funded programs are running virtually as able and appropriate.

Some YB funded summer programs made modifications to offer in-person programming for smaller groups and/or virtual experiences for youth.

RUNNING THIS SUMMER: (most with modifications i.e. reduced number of youth and/or programming:

- Empowered Girls Circles - run by Maternal Infant Services Network
- Junior Police Academy - run by Town of Newburgh Police Department
- Summer Recreation - run by the City of Newburgh
- Summer Youth Leadership Academies - run by Fearless HV, Nora Cronin Presentation Academy, Town of Crawford Recreation, and Winslow Therapeutic Riding

NOTE: The City Middletown Recreation WILL continue to run ONLY Summer Feeding Program (Playground activities that were originally funded through the Youth Bureau have been cancelled.)

CANCELLED:

- Basketball Program - run by the City of Newburgh
- Summer Camps and Recreation Programs - run by the Town of New Windsor, Village of Florida and Village of Warwick
- Summer Youth Employment Program - run by the Village of Walden
(NOTE: different from Summer Youth Employment Program run through the OC Employment & Training Administration)
- Summer Youth Leadership Academies - run by the City of Middletown and Warwick Community Bandwagon

Stopped for the Summer, but hope to be open in the Fall:

- Youth Task Force - run by the Warwick Community Bandwagon
- Youth/Teen Centers - run by the City of Port Jervis and the Village of Walden
