On or about July 10, 2020, the County of Orange will submit a request to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to release federal Community Development Block Grant funds under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (P.L. 93-383) to undertake the following project in the County:

V. South Blooming Grove: Public Infrastructure The scope of this project would be to reshape and appropriately slope swales, replace existing structures in kind and replace damaged driveway culvert piping as needed to improve stormwater flow in the project area. Specifically, the project involves:

- Replacing fourteen (14) existing culverts with 12” HDPE culvert piping
- Replacing eighteen (18) existing culverts with 15” HDPE culvert piping
- Swale redevelopment of approximately 2750 feet of roadside drainage swales
- Replacing / Rebuilding approximately 3 structurally deficient storm water structures

Estimated FY2020 Funding: \$80,000

The activities proposed are categorically excluded under HUD regulations at 24 CFR Part 58 from National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) requirements. Additional project information is contained in the Environmental Review Record (ERR). The ERR will be made available to the public for review either electronically or by U.S. mail. PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group or agency may submit written comments on the ERR to the Director of the Orange County Office of Community Development; 40 Matthews Street, Suite 307A; Goshen, NY 10924. All comments received by July 9, 2020, will be considered by the County of Orange prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds.

ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

The County of Orange certifies to HUD that Steven M. Neuhaus, in his capacity as County Executive of the County of Orange, consents to accept the jurisdiction of the federal courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process, and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. HUD’s approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows the County of Orange to use CDBG and HOME Program funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

HUD will accept objections to its release of funds and the County of Orange’s certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the County of Orange; (b) the County of Orange has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other

participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by HUD; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted via email in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to the New York Office of Community Planning and Development CPD_COVID-19OEE-NY@hud.gov Potential objectors should contact HUD New York via email to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
