## PRIORITY 2

### Transportation

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- Bike racks and a Bike Fix-It station will be added at the Newburgh Free Library.
- More than 30 crosswalks across Newburgh are being updated with paint and reflective glass beads to improve walkability and bikeability as part of a *Complete Streets* policy, making it safer to get where you need to go.

## PRIORITY 1

### Community Upkeep + Housing

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- In Fall of 2019, a *Who's Who* event was held at the library featuring local housing organizations. Another event is tentatively planned for later this year.
- Housing needs assessments are currently happening. One focused on Single Room Occupancies has been completed and another comprehensive assessment is in progress, to be completed in Fall 2020. **A housing resource guide will be developed for the community.**
- The Newburgh Housing Committee met regularly prior to COVID-19 to address community identified priorities, virtual meetings are beginning in July 2020. ## PRIORITY 3

### Chronic Stress + Mental Health

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- By Fall 2020, program materials for adults and kids will be available to borrow from the Newburgh Free Library to support addressing mental health and trauma. The materials specifically focus on meditation, mindfulness, yoga, resilience, and grief.
- The library is also expanding their own programming for the public addressing mental health, including chronic stress and trauma.
- Community organizations are now prioritizing mental health and trauma this year, as result of this work.
