### City of Middletown - Maple Ave Drainage Improvements

- Maple Hill Park and several residential properties experienced severe flooding as a result of Hurricane Irene and Tropical Storm Lee—as a result the park and residential homes sustained damage. The improvements have resulted in an integrated stormwater handling system that will control stormwater runoff from future storms, thereby minimizing stormwater impact to these areas.

- The installation of a new concrete box culvert, new outlets structure at existing pond in Maple Hill Park, regrading/straightening existing drainage channel, and construction of new stormwater detention basin and outlet. Improvements will correct the severe flooding of residential properties that border the park
