- Improvements included removal of concrete panels lining Monhagen Drainageway that were damaged during Hurricane Irene and Tropical Storm Lee replaced with new channel walls with larger cross-section and extended to upstream end of project area.
- The result of Hurricane Irene & Tropical Storm Lee is the flooding of the residential areas of 210-246 West Main St. & 43-51 California Ave. When the storms hit, the current condition of the existing downstream concrete box culvert opening (10'x6') was inadequate for the storm conditions.
