EXECUTIVE ORDER  
No. 3 of 2018

**I, WAYNE BOOTH**, Deputy County Executive and Acting County Executive of the County of Orange, New York, do hereby declare the following:


**WHEREAS**, on May 15, 2018 I declared a State of Emergency and issued four orders in relation thereto; and

**WHEREAS**, such State of Emergency and related Orders were to expire on May 16, 2018 at 7:00 AM; and

**WHEREAS**, I have determined that given the number of power outages and circumstances such as downed trees that it is appropriate to continue that State of Emergency and related Orders;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I do hereby find that the County of Orange public safety to be imperiled by said storm and, consequently, to safeguard the health and welfare of the public, I continue the aforesaid State of Emergency and accompanying Orders until 7:00 AM on May 17, 2018 and I direct this declaration and Order to be published and filed along with the prior issued declaration and Order.
