 Subject: General Order - Map of Designated Zones

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this General Order is to define the three (3) patrol zones of the Orange County Sheriff's Office. The County of Orange is divided into the three (3) geographical areas known as zones. These zones are then subdivided three (3) times each into sectors. These zones serve as a reference for the allocation of Road Division Deputies in accordance with their assigned duties.

**I. ZONE ONE:**

Shall consist of the incorporated cities of Middletown and Port Jervis, the towns of Deerpark (including the hamlets of Cahoonzie, Cuddebackville, Godeffroy, Huguenot, Rio and Sparrowbush), Greenville, Goshen, Minisink (including the hamlet of Johnson and Westtown), Mount Hope, Walkill (including the hamlets of Circleville, Howells, Mechanicstown, Scotchtown, Silver Lake) and Wawayanda (including the hamlets of New Hampton and Slate Hill), and the villages of Goshen, Otisville and Unionville.

**A. SECTOR A:**

Shall consist of the incorporated city of Port Jervis, and the towns of Deerpark and Mount Hope, and the village of Otisville.

**B. SECTOR B:**

Shall consist of the incorporated city of Middletown and the town of Walkill.

**C. SECTOR C:**

Shall consist of the incorporated towns of Greenville, Goshen, Minisink and Wawayanda, and the villages of Goshen and Unionville.

**II. ZONE TWO:**

Shall consist of the incorporated city of Newburgh, the towns of Crawford (including the hamlets of Bullville, Pine Bush and Thompson Ridge), Hamptonburgh (including the hamlet of Campbell Hall), Montgomery (including the hamlets of East Coldenham and Coldenham), Newburgh (including the hamlets of Leptondale, Middle Hope and Rosten) and New Windsor (including the hamlets of Burnside, Little Britain, Rock Tavern and Vails Gate) and the villages of Maybrook, Montgomery and Walden.

- A. SECTOR A:  
Shall consist of the incorporated towns of Crawford and Montgomery and the villages of Montgomery and Walden.
- B. SECTOR B:  
Shall consist of the incorporated city of Newburgh and the town of Newburgh.
- C. SECTOR C:  
Shall consist of the incorporated towns of Hamptonburgh and New Windsor, and the village of Maybrook.

III. ZONE THREE:  
Shall consist of the incorporated towns of Blooming Grove (including the hamlet of Salisbury Mills), Chester (including the unincorporated communities of Greycourt and Oxford Depot and the hamlet of Sugar Loaf), Cornwall (including the unincorporated community of Mountainville), Florida, Highlands (including the United States Military Academy at West Point), Kiryas Joel, Monroe, Tuxedo (including the hamlets of Arden and Southfields), Warwick (including the hamlets of Bellvale, Pine Island and Sterling Forest) and Woodbury (including the hamlets of Central Valley and Highland Mills), and the villages of Chester, Cornwall on Hudson, Greenwood Lake, Harriman, Highland Falls, Monroe, Tuxedo Park, Washingtonville and Warwick.

A. SECTOR A:  
Shall consist of the incorporated towns of Tuxedo and Warwick, and the villages of Florida, Greenwood Lake, Tuxedo Park and Warwick.

B. SECTOR B:  
Shall consist of the incorporated towns of Chester, Monroe and Woodbury, and the villages of Chester, Kiryas Joel, Harriman and Monroe.

C. SECTOR C:  
Shall consist of the incorporated towns of Blooming Grove and Cornwall, Highlands and the villages of Cornwall on Hudson, Highland Falls, and Washingtonville.

IV. MAP POSTING:  
A map of Orange County outlined with Zones 1, 2 and 3 shall be posted in the Squad Room and in the Civil Unit Office.
