**ORANGE COUNTY CDBG-DR 2012 ACTION PLAN
PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD ANNOUNCEMENT**

May 10, 2021

Orange County is the recipient of a CDBG Disaster Recovery Grant (CDBG-DR) in accordance with Title IV of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act. These funds are being made available to assist disaster recovery efforts in response to Hurricane Irene and Tropical Storm Lee. The County has been allocated \$11,422,029. These funds are allocated to the County as a direct recipient as the Orange County CDBG Urban Consortium area had more than \$10 million in unmet severe needs. In order to receive the aforementioned funds, the County prepared and submitted an Action Plan to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) on July 20, 2012. The Action Plan was approved by HUD on August 10, 2012.

At this time, Orange County is submitting substantial amendment 2012-06 to the approved Action Plan to Address the following program changes:

- Reallocate unspent and reduced activity funding to other funding categories to prepare for responses to the open Request for Applications for Public Facilities/Infrastructure projects due on June 25, 2021.
 - In addition, activities which were originally planned but never occurred due to ineligibility have been deleted from the action plan.

The 7-day comment period will begin on Monday, May 10, 2021 and extend through close of business on Tuesday, May 18, 2021. 1. Reallocate unspent and reduced activity funding to other funding categories to prepare for responses to the open Request for Applications for Public Facilities/Infrastructure projects due on June 25, 2021.
 - a. In addition, activities which were originally planned but never occurred due to ineligibility have been deleted from the action plan.

The County currently has a request for applications open for additional infrastructure projects which is due on June 25, 2021. We have reallocated all unspent resources to the Public Facilities/Infrastructure allocation of our Action Plan to prepare for the responses.

The current approved Action Plan, 2018-05, estimated the completion date of September 30, 2024. Before this, Orange County received approval from HUD for Substantial Amendment Action Plan, 2018-04, estimated a 12-month timeline, with the completion date of September 30, 2019, 2012-03 which amended the current grant completion date from September 30, 2017 to September 30, 2018. Substantial Amendment 2012-02 requested HUD approve an additional 12-month extension, from October 1, 2016 to September 30, 2017, in order to complete projects in the pipeline. Substantial Amendment 2012-01 which extended the completion date to September 30, 2016. HUD approved that request and the deadline was extended to September 30, 2017.

City of Middletown CDBG-DR projects- West Main St. and Maple Ave projects are complete. Service delivery to be drawn.

The Village of Walden CDBG- DR Pine Street Pump Station project will have one remaining final draw for project expenses. Service delivery to be drawn.
