



Employment Integration Assistance Program

A program developed in conjunction with The Orange County Employment and Training Administration to assist with employment reintegration for individuals displaced from the workforce as a result of the opioid crisis.

- ◆ *Have you or someone you know been affected by the Opioid Crisis?*
- ◆ *Would you be interested in making a positive impact on the Opioid Crisis?*
- ◆ *Are you a dislocated worker?*
- ◆ *Do professions that could provide relief to the crisis such as mental healthcare, addiction treatment or pain management services interest you?*
- ◆ *Eligible participants do not have to have had a personal history with opioid use disorder.*

Eligible Participants will be provided with funding for:

CAREER SERVICES

- ◆ *One on one sessions with a coach to create an individualized plan*
- ◆ *Education, training, and job placement assistance*
- ◆ *Essential skills and professional etiquette development necessary for employment*
- ◆ *Employment performance items such as resume writing, interviewing skills, time management and computer skills building*
