Essential for Living is especially useful for learners with limited communication repertoires, minimal daily living skills, and/or severe problem behavior. It identifies eight essential domains broken down into a sequence for teaching “must have” skills needed to function effectively plus “should have”, “good to have” and “nice to have” skills based on concepts and principles of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA), with an emphasis on development of alternative forms of communication. It can provide a structure and framework for developing meaningful and appropriate ISP and IEP goals, objectives, valued outcomes, community and day habilitation plans and more.
