June 6th 6:30 p.m. – 8:30 p.m. (Monday)	2	Core 1A	<u>Working in a Family's Home: Key Points You Need to Understand:</u> (OCCSI Staff Only) Understand the diversity and complexities of families; parenting styles and values that can influence and impact the work; identify behaviors and situations that present challenges e.g., boundaries, conflicts of interest, confidentiality, accepting gifts, etc.
June 8th 6:30 p.m. – 8:30 p.m. (Wednesday)	2	Core	<u>Supporting People in their Own Home-II: (OCCSI Staff Only)</u> Identification of suspicious activity (trafficking, gangs, drugs); safety in the neighborhood, teaching difference between friendships vs. toxic relationships, avoiding victimization and eviction; Identity theft, special considerations for those parenting, and more.
June 11th 10 a.m. – 12 p.m. (Saturday)	2	Core 5A	<u>Social Skill Building for Children 12 and Under with Autism and Other Developmental Disabilities:</u> Learn strategies for teaching social and communication skills, and the “hidden social rules”. While most people learn through experience/observation; people with ASD need to be taught. If not, consequences can lead to isolation, depression, bullying, more.
June 11th 1 p.m. – 3 p.m. (Saturday)	2	Consult	<u>Could I be Contributing to that Problem Behavior?</u> Explore Reinforcement basics, how to apply schedules, importance of consistency, simple strategies to approach & engage
