The Western Maryland Information Center has been notified of a popular drug trend in Allegany County, MD. **Wasp spray** is being crystallized and sold as a meth substitute. This is called "wasping" and "wasp meth". In Cumberland it is called "Dizzy Meth". It is slightly cheaper than regular meth and increasingly popular.

Subjects using wasp spray meth have been experiencing symptoms of ***paranoia and aggression***. Overdoses are also common. The finished product can resemble meth or rock salt, often having a glossier appearance than meth crystals. This product **does not test positive with drug tests**. A check of open sources shows encounters with subjects using "wasp spray meth" in Kentucky and West Virginia.
