EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2 OF 2022
UPDATING UNIFORM GUIDANCE REFERENCES IN THE COUNTY
PROCUREMENT POLICY

I, Steven M. Neuhaus, County Executive of the County of Orange, State of New York, do hereby declare as an EXECUTIVE ORDER the following:

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Orange County Charter Article 3, Section 3.02(1), the adoption, modification, and implementation of the County of Orange Procurement Policy is the responsibility of the County Executive; and

WHEREAS, the federal Office of Management and Budget ("OMB") regulates federal funding awards by and through 2 C.F.R. Part 200 (the "Uniform Guidance") that impact County of Orange procurements; and

WHEREAS, OMB also, from time to time, updates 2 C.F.R. Part 200, Appendix XI (the "Compliance Supplement") that addresses the applicability of Uniform Guidance requirements for the various federal agency funding programs; and

WHEREAS, OMB last issued an updated Uniform Guidance, effective November 12, 2020 (the "2020 Update"); and

WHEREAS, the County of Orange Procurement Policy references to the Uniform Guidance were impacted by the 2020 Update,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, effective immediately, the County of Orange Procurement Policy be modified and amended as follows to conform to the 2020 Update to the Uniform Guidance:

All references in the County of Orange Procurement Policy to the federal Uniform Guidance requirements referenced above are to be construed as referencing the applicable 2020 Update requirements and that any 2020 Update requirements not otherwise referenced in the County of Orange Procurement Policy are hereby incorporated therein by reference, and it is further

ORDERED that all County procurements using federal funds and made in accordance with the County of Orange Procurement Policy shall be made in accordance with the applicable 2020 Update to the Uniform Guidance Compliance Supplement.
