Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

Eligibility at a Glance (Apply to Confirm)

Household must meet certain income and resource limits, and work requirements to be eligible to receive SNAP benefits.

Although not typically eligible for SNAP, students and non-citizens can receive SNAP benefits under specific qualifications.

Non-Citizens:

“Generally, to qualify for SNAP, non-citizens must meet one of the following criteria:

- Have lived in the United States for at least 5 years.
- Be receiving disability-related assistance or benefits.
- Be children under 18.”

People experiencing homelessness do not need to meet certain residential requirements.

Women, Infants, and Children Program (WIC)

Eligibility at a Glance (Apply to Confirm)

Applicants must meet all of the following eligibility requirements:

- Categorical:** The following individuals are considered categorically eligible for WIC:
 - Women
Pregnant (during pregnancy and up to 6 weeks after the birth of an infant or the end of the pregnancy)
Postpartum (up to six months after the birth of the infant or the end of the pregnancy)
Breastfeeding (up to the infant's first birthday)
 - Infants (up to the infant's first birthday)
 - Children (up to the child's fifth birthday)
- Residential:** Applicants must live in the state in which they apply
- Income:** Applicants must have income at or below an income level or standard set by the state agency or be determined automatically income-eligible based on participation in certain programs (including SNAP benefits, Medicaid, Temporary Assistance for Needy Families, etc.)
- Nutrition Risk:** A health professional or WIC staff must determine whether the individual is at nutritional risk.

Non-citizens are eligible to receive WIC benefits if they meet the general eligibility requirements.
