# Fire Scene Preservation Seminar

Provides firefighters, fire officers, and police officers with an understanding of the importance of fire scene preservation as well as an understanding of their roles and responsibilities in support of successful investigation of the origin and cause of fires. Using photos and information from fire investigations in NYS and Orange County, topics to be covered include legal responsibilities; scene preservation techniques; observations on the fireground; recognition and preservation of potential evidence; importance of early fire scene photos; accidental vs. criminal causes; fatal fires; fire scene spoliation issues; agency roles and interagency cooperation; the five degrees of the crime of arson; and firefighter arson issues. Participants will receive a county issued training certificate.
