RESOLUTION OF THE LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF ORANGE HONORING THE MEMORY OF BERNARD WINSTANLEY, OUTSTANDING CITIZEN, DEDICATED PUBLIC SERVANT AND COUNTY LEGISLATOR FOR THE TENTH LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, it is fitting and appropriate to recognize the career and life of an outstanding citizen, United States Navy Veteran, dedicated public servant, volunteer fireman and respected friend and colleague on this regular meeting of the Orange County Legislature; and

WHEREAS, BERNARD WINSTANLEY established a prominent place in the local and county community. He epitomized the fundamental virtues upon which our Nation is founded and set an example to which all persons may aspire. The life of Bernard Winstanley demonstrates that love of and service to his country, family, community and a personal conviction to work hard and strive for excellence are key to a life of fulfillment; and

WHEREAS, BERNARD WINSTANLEY and his spouse Genevieve ("Gen") were active participants in their local community of Greenwood Lake, committing themselves to the Greenwood Lake Lions, Warwick Rotary, American Legion and the local fire department. Bernard Winstanley had a soft heart for residents in his district who fell on hard times. He always provided legislative guidance and personal assistance to his constituents on many social and economic issues that had a direct impact on their well-being and quality-of-life; and

WHEREAS, BERNARD WINSTANLEY influenced every important public policy decision made during his outstanding fifteen-year Legislative career. During his tenure he served on or chaired numerous Legislative committees, including the Health and Mental Health Committee, the Rules, Enactments and Intergovernmental Relations Committee, Public Safety and Emergency Services Committee, Social Services Committee, Personnel and Compensation Committee, Education and Economic Development Committee, Labor Relations Advisory Committee, and the Off-Track Betting Special Committee; and

WHEREAS, BERNARD WINSTANLEY, will forever be remembered for his contributions to the design of the Veterans Memorial at the Orange County Veterans Cemetery, Goshen New York, the county seat, where Ben and Gen have found their final resting place in the County they so dearly loved. His service to the County of Orange is most deeply appreciated.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ORANGE COUNTY EXECUTIVE, ON BEHALF OF THE ORANGE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, TO ENTER INTO A SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AUTHORIZING THE IMPLEMENTATION, AND FUNDING IN THE FIRST INSTANCE 100% OF THE FEDERAL-AID ELIGIBLE COSTS OF A TRANSPORTATION FEDERAL-AID EMERGENCY PROJECT, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFORE.

WHEREAS, a Project for the emergency repair work to correct damages caused by Hurricane Irene on August 26, 2011, at various locations in Orange County, PIN 8701.66 (the "Project") is eligible for funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, as amended, for Federal emergency relief that calls for the apportionment of the costs of the Emergency Repair to be borne at the ratio of 100% Federal funds and 0% non-federal funds; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 125 adopted by the Orange County Legislature on June 7, 2012 approved and agreed to advance the Project by making a commitment of 100% of the non-federal share of the construction costs thereof; and

WHEREAS, it was subsequently found necessary to undertake additional construction work not contemplated in the original Agreement authorized by the previous Resolution; and

WHEREAS, it has been found necessary to increase the federal and non-federal share of costs for the additional construction work for the project; and

WHEREAS, Orange County desires to advance the Project by making a commitment of 100% of the non-Federal share of the costs thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Orange County Legislature, duly convened does hereby

RESOLVE, that the Orange County Legislature hereby approves the above-subject project; and it is hereby further

RESOLVED, that the Orange County Legislature hereby authorizes the County of Orange to pay in the first instance 100% of the Federal and non-Federal share of the cost of the construction work for the Project or portions thereof; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the sum of \$543,197.00 (\$1,999,891.00 minus previous \$1,456,694.00) is hereby appropriated from the County Capital Project No. 223 and made available to cover the cost of participation in the above phase of the Project; and it is further

RESOLVED, that in the event the full Federal and non-Federal share costs of the project exceeds the amount appropriated above, the Orange County Legislature shall convene as soon as possible to appropriate said excess amount immediately upon the notification by the County Executive thereof; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive of Orange County be and is hereby authorized to execute all necessary Agreements, certifications or reimbursement requests for Federal Aid on behalf of the County of Orange with the New York State Department of Transportation in connection with the advancement or approval of the Project and providing for the administration of the Project and the municipality's first instance funding of project costs and permanent funding of the local share of Federal-Aid and State-Aid eligible Project costs and all Project costs within appropriations therefore, that are not so eligible; and it is further

RESOLVED, that in addition to the County Executive, the following municipal titles: Commissioner of Public Works, Commissioner of Finance, or their designees, are also hereby authorized to execute any necessary Agreements or certifications on behalf of the Municipality with NYS DOT in connection with the advancement or approval of the project identified in the State/Local Agreement; and it is further

RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this Resolution be filed with the New York State Commissioner of Transportation by attaching it to any necessary Agreement in connection with the Project; and it is further

RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately.

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE RELEASE OF THE COUNTY'S INTEREST IN AND TO A CERTAIN DEED SALE PARCEL TO THE PREVIOUS OWNER OF RECORD, PURSUANT TO SECTION FIVE, PARAGRAPH B.1. OF LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 2010.

WHEREAS, this Legislature, by Local Law No. 2 of 2010, Section Five, Paragraph B.1., authorized the Orange County Commissioner of Finance (Enforcing Officer) to release the County's interest in and to a certain deed sale parcel, and to allow the previous owner of record to purchase his or her parcel.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby

RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Finance is hereby authorized to release the County's interest in and to a certain deed sale parcel to the previous owner of record, as listed on attached **Schedule "A,"** which sale price shall include the total of outstanding taxes, interest, fees and penalties, as shown on the list submitted to the Legislature; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the County Attorney shall effect the release of the County's interest in said parcel by preparing and submitting to the appropriate Court, an Order discontinuing the in rem tax foreclosure action as to said property, canceling the Notice of Pendency of such action as to said property, and vacating and setting aside the Judgment of Foreclosure and the Deed executed and recorded pursuant to said Judgment of Foreclosure as to said property. The entry of such Order shall restore all parties, including owner, mortgagees and any and all lienors, receivers and administrators and encumbrancers, to the status they held at the time the County acquired title to said property as if the Judgment had never been rendered, and shall render said property liable for all taxes, beneficiaries, management fees and liens, penalties, interest, and other charges which shall accrue subsequent to those paid in order to obtain the release provided for or which were, for whatever reason, omitted from the payment made to obtain such release.

RESOLUTION OF THE ORANGE COUNTY LEGISLATURE URGING THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK AND THE NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATURE TO RESTORE STATE AID TO COMMUNITY COLLEGES AT THE LEVELS REQUIRED BY NEW YORK STATE EDUCATION LAW.

WHEREAS, New York State Education Law Article 26 provides the methodology for funding community colleges under the State University of New York; and

WHEREAS, State Education Law provides for funding through state aid, a county sponsor contribution and student tuition and fees; and

WHEREAS, State Education Law stipulates that state aid should equal one-third of community college operating costs; and

WHEREAS, over the course of time, the State of New York, has substantially reduced the amount of state aid it contributes to the operations costs of the community colleges, thus shifting the burden of financing higher education to the host counties and students; and

WHEREAS, in State fiscal year 2007-08 the State budget support student base aid for SUNY and CUNY community colleges per full time student at \$2,675 the State fiscal year 2012-13 state budget included final base operating aid funding for community colleges at \$2,272 per full time student, representing a 15 percent reduction from prior year state aid levels, not accounting for inflationary costs pressures since; and

WHEREAS, the reduction in state aid perpetuates New York State's actions of imposing increasingly more costly funded mandates on county taxpayers and student in a manner that is inconsistent with State Education Law.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, We, the Orange County Legislature, do hereby urge the Governor of the State of New York and the New York State Legislature to restore Community College State base operating aid to the levels envisioned under New York State Education Law in order to maintain academic excellence and affordability at our community colleges; and

RESOLVED, that individual copies of this resolution be conveyed to the Governor of the State of New York, to the Senate Majority Leader, the Speaker of the House and to each member of the State Senate and Assembly whose districts include all or part of Orange County, the Chancellor of the State University of New York, Orange County Community College Office of the President and to the Director of the New York Association of Counties so that they may be apprised hereof and take all necessary and appropriate action to effectuate the purpose of this resolution; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Legislature shall transmit copies of this resolution to the Clerks of all other county legislatures throughout New York State.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE ORANGE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH, TO ACCEPT FUNDS FROM THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF MENTAL HEALTH, PURSUANT TO SECTION 99-h OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW AND SECTION 4.09 OF THE ORANGE COUNTY CHARTER.

WHEREAS, this Legislature does wish to provide funds to the 2012 budget of the Orange County Department of Mental Health in the amount of \$14,963.00 for the Children's Mental Health Clinics Co-Located in Primary Care Settings. The Orange County Department of Mental Health received a two-year grant to provide satellite outpatient children's behavioral health services within a community pediatric health care practice in order to provide integrated physical and behavioral health care to children in the Port Jervis community. The primary focus of this collaborative, co-located project is early assessment and treatment of children's behavioral health issues within a wellness
