The State Legislature prepared Census data for each County in which state prisoners were not counted at the location of the prison where they were held on April 1, 2010, but reassigned to the Census block in which they had resided prior to their incarceration. Thus, the adjusted population of Orange County as of April 1, 2010 is approximately 371,284 people.

*Note:* "Current Approximate Population" refers to the population of each County Legislative District, aggregated from Census blocks, as of April 1, 2010. This number is not exact, as the County election and legislative districts do not conform to the boundaries of Census blocks, but are within a margin of error of 0.4%.
