Redistricting throughout New York State in 2010 requires the reapportionment of inmates in state prisons. The State Legislature prepared Census data for each County in which prisoners were not counted at the location of the prison, but reassigned to the Census block in which they had resided prior to their incarceration. Thus, the adjusted population of Orange County is approximately 371,284 people. Equal representation regulations require that each district be as nearly equal in population as is feasible, making the adjusted mean population of each new district 17,680 people.
