This may include various forms of dependency including Alcoholism and other Addiction problems as well as less clearly defined abuses of various substances both legal and illegal.

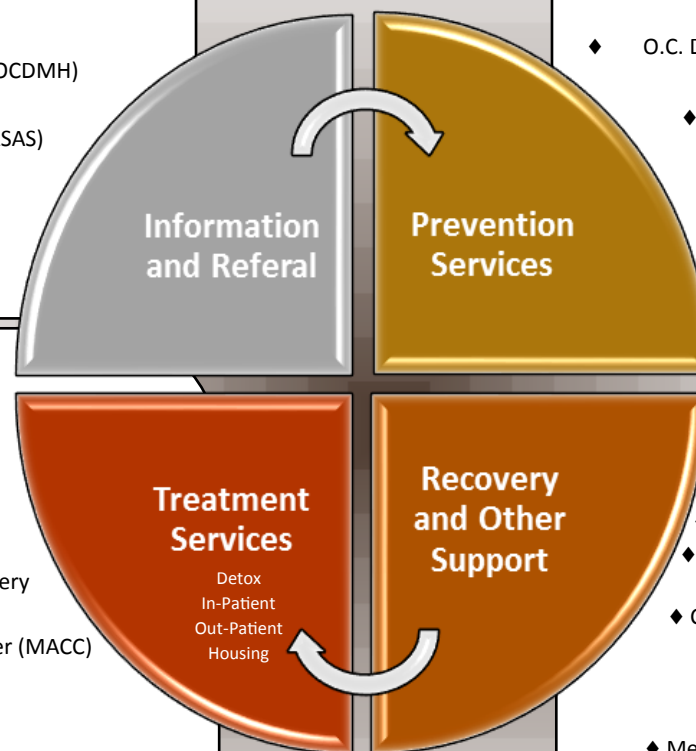
### What services are available?

*Types of Treatment and Prevention Services:*

There are various types of services that may have a positive effect on people in regard to their use or potential use and/or abuse of alcohol and other drugs. They may include **"Prevention"** services, which are designed to prevent the use or abuse of substances. **"Intervention"** services, which are ways of identifying persons with problems or potential alcohol and substance abuse problems then linking to treatment. **"Treatment"** services, which help people to stop using and abusing substances and recover from the effects of use and abuse. **"Recovery"** and other supports which are formal and informal services available for continuing and maintaining a recovery oriented life.
