I, **Jean M. Ramppen**, Clerk of the Orange County Legislature of the County of Orange, New York **DO HEREBY CERTIFY** as follows:


On July 10, 2017, Petitioners Agent, Gedalye Szegedin, on behalf of all petitioners and the 2 additional agents, filed an Amendment to the Petition for Division of the Town of Monroe (originally filed on September 12, 2016) with the undersigned.

The amendment revises Exhibits A and B to the Petition, reflecting a modified Legal Common Boundary Description and Map, respectively, reducing the total area of the proposed new Town outside of the Village of Kiryas Joel (as it exists now) to 56+/- acres. The revised Exhibits are intended to supersede and replace for all purposes the current Common Boundary Description and Map in the Petition presently before the Legislature.

In addition, the original proposed name of the new town as presented in the petition was Town of North Monroe. Petitioners Agent withdraws the name of North Monroe and instead requests that the name of the new town be called Town of Palm Tree.

The amended Metes and Bounds description and Map have been reviewed by the Orange County Commissioner of Planning for accuracy (see attached).
